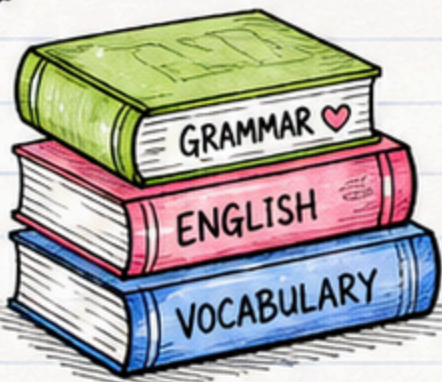

1 What is English Grammar?

English Grammar is the set of rules that helps us to use words correctly in speaking and writing.



Grammar tells us how to make correct sentences and express our thoughts clearly.

2 Why Grammar is Important?

- It helps us to speak correctly.
- It helps us to write clearly.
- It helps others to understand us.
- It builds confidence in communication.

3 How Grammar Helps in Speaking and Writing?



In Speaking → Grammar helps us to speak clear, correct and confident.



In Writing → Grammar helps us to write correct, neat and meaningful sentences.

4 What is a Sentence?

A sentence is a group of words that gives complete meaning.

Examples:

- ✓ I play cricket.
- ✓ She is happy.

Subject & Predicate

Every sentence has **two** main parts:

① **SUBJECT**

② **PREDICATE**

The person, thing,
or idea we talk about.

What we say
about the subject.

Let's Understand with Examples

| ① | Rahul plays football. | → | Rahul | → | plays football |

| ② | Birds fly in the sky. | → | Birds | → | fly in the sky |

| ③ | My mother cooks food. | → | My mother | → | cooks food |
| | | | Subject | | Predicate |

Easy Trick to Identify Subject

Ask this simple question:
"Who or What is
doing something?"

The answer is the **SUBJECT**!

Common Mistake Alert

Subject is **NOT** always
the first word only.

Example:

Under the table is a cat.
(Subject)

3 Simple Steps!

STEP 1

Find the Action

Look for the
verb (action word)
in the sentence.

STEP 2

Ask "Who?" or
"What?"

Ask the question
about the action.

STEP 3

Answer = Subject

The answer you get
is the **SUBJECT**.

Let's Understand with Examples

1

Riya sings beautifully.

Who?

Action (Verb)

How?

Who sings? → Riya

✓ Subject



2

The dog barked loudly.

Who?

Action (Verb)

How?

Who barked? → The dog

✓ Subject



3

My friends are studying.

Who?

Action (Verb)

Who are studying? → My friends

✓ Subject



Remember in 5 Seconds!

Ask WHO?



Get Subject

Always locate the **VERB** first.
When you find the action,
it becomes easy to
find the subject!

Memory Hack

Subject is the one
who does the action
or is talking about
the action.
